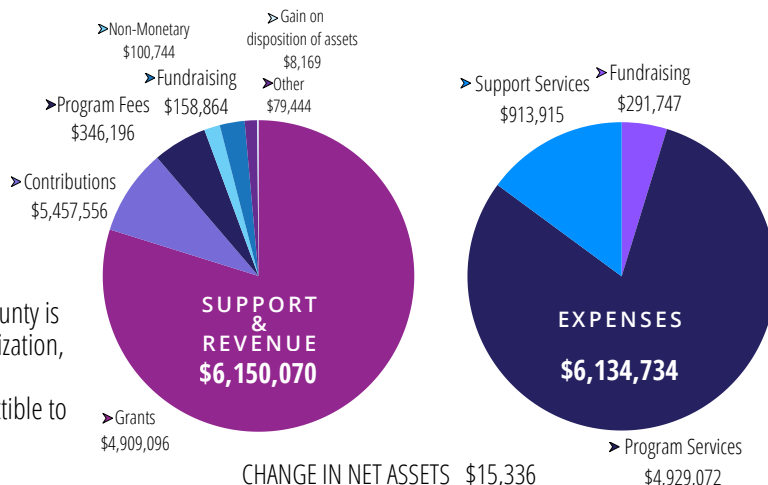

Growing at Goshen Family Center

In the past year, our resource center in Goshen has experienced remarkable growth. Both walk-ins and participation has risen significantly. From March 2025 to March 2026, we have recorded:

- 64 First Five Case Management Cases
- 3,075 walk-ins
- 16,600 diapers distributed monthly
- 600 Food Boxes distributed monthly
